Down a goal in the third period isn't where you want to be but it's a good time to find out what you're made of and tonight the Vets response, while never flawless, was strong. About 5 minutes after the New Hamburg go-ahead goal, Griffin Sinden made absolutely no mistake off a low feed from Baker. His one timer beating Murphy clean and bringing the Vets square again. As the third period moved on, both sides had chances to break the deadlock but the buzzer would sound sending the game to overtime.

In overtime, both sides continued to trade blows but it was ultimately New Hamburg that found the net as Zach Mark tipped a point shot, beating a screened Brett.

At the end of the day, the Vets depart with some positives and negatives in sight. While they still managed a point, there is still much to improve on as they move through the still very young season.
