The Navy Vets landed one of the most skilled players at the trade deadline in Wes Dobbin. The 21-year-old from London signed with the Navy Vets in the summer of 2020 after posting nearly a point per game in four Greater Ontario Junior Hockey League seasons.

Dobbin had nine goals and 15 points in 26 games during the London Nationals' playoff run in 2018-19 that ended with a seven-game loss to Waterloo Siskins in the Sutherland Cup final.

The pandemic wiped out last season, and Dobbin wasn't able to commit in 2021-22 until Vets GM Matt Fidlin reached out one more time.

Fidlin also swung a deal to add forward Tommy Zufelt from Hespeler for future compensation. The 20-year-old had 12 goals and 16 points in 21 games for the Shamrocks and adds speed and skill, along with an offensive touch.

The Vets currently sit in 3rd place 6 points back of both Wellesley and 2nd place Tavistock Braves but with 3 games in hand on the Braves and 1 game in hand on the Applejacks ...

Vets captain Kyle Baker leads the division scoring race by 10 points looking to become the 1st Navy Vet to lead the division in scoring since Jeremy Demarest in the 2001-02 season and at current pace could have one of the best point scoring seasons in franchise history.
