Kitching, Fraser Best Goaltenders

Ken Kitching and Art Fraser have brought Navy Vets the Inter-County Junior "C" goal-tending title.

Kitching's brilliant 2.92 mark and Fraser's 3.12 combined to give the club a sparkling 3.02 goals against average tabulated by minutes played. Vets allowed only 94 goals over their 30-game slate, nine less than Dundas Blues permitted in 29 games. Blues finished with a 3.47 mark.

Right winger Mike Fitzgerald took top honors in the individual scoring derby with 42 points. He led the club in assists with 22 and his 20 goals made him one of a select group of four that broke the 30-goal barrier.

Pivot Gary Thorne — the early season leader — finished as runner-up, two points behind. He also fired 20 goals and helped on a similar number. Reg Eglisson garnered 39 points to trail Thorne by one. His total comprised of 20 goals and 19 helpers.

Fourth place Dan McMillan was the remaining 30-goal sniper. He scored 21 times to lead the team.

Defenceman Brian Shelton was the team penalty king with a whopping 124 minutes in only 29 games. He took the title by virtue of a late surge. The entire team amassed 740 minutes, an average of almost 25 per game.
