Thorne Tops Vets Playoff Scoring

The line of Gary Thorne, Don Izzard Jr., and Scott Seagrist dominated scoring in Navy Vets' 17 playoff games.

Centre Thorne was the top shooter with 20 points on eight goals and a team-high 12 assists. Forward Izzard shared goal-scoring honors with Mike Fitzgerald at 10. He was also credited with nine assists for 19 points, one shy of Thorne. Right winger Seagrist assumed fourth position behind Fitzgerald. He connected seven times and added the same number of assists.

Fitzgerald set up five markers to give him a one point edge over Seagrist. Fitzgerald's linemates finished in a deadlock for fifth place. Fred Slater and Reg Egilsson each scored four goals and helped on nine others for 13 points.

Vets were eliminated from Ontario Junior "C" competition by New Hamburg Hahns. The Woodstock representatives lost the best-of-seven series in five games after claiming the Inter-County loop championship with triumphs over Ingersoll Marlands and Dundas Blues.

Vets were outscored, 67-66 in their 17 post-season games. Hahns accounted for this slender margin by outscoring them, 27-12.

Goalies Ken Kitching and Art Fraser combined for an average of 3.86 tabulated by minutes played. Kitching sported the lowest mark at 3.32 and Fraser followed at 4.42.
