



GAME PREVIEW – JAN.13

The Navy Vets host the Wellesley Applejacks at Southwood Arena on Friday night. The Applejacks have won 3 of the 4 meetings between the teams so far this season ... including the last 3 in a row.

The Vets are coming off a 5-3 loss in Tavistock last Friday night in their return from the holiday break.

Wellesley beat visiting Tavistock 6-3 last Saturday night ... their 5th straight win.
